CODE OF CONDUCT

Hillside Village is committed to providing an enjoyable shopping experience for our guest. While visiting Hillside Village, the following general activities will NOT be tolerated:



- Loitering or otherwise assembling for the purpose of disturbing the public peace, gambling or committing any unlawful act.
- 2. Using obscene language or gesture, racial, religious or ethnic slurs which could create disturbance, or disrupt the peace of customers, retailers and/or employees of the property.
- 3. Displaying or wearing any item which depicts sexually explicit activity, illegal activity or obscene or offensive language which could create a disturbance or disrupt the peace of customer, retailers and /or employees of the property.
- **4.** Physically and verbally threatening any person, fighting, annoying others through noisy or boisterous activities or by unnecessary staring or following another person throughout the property, or by using sexually explicit language or conduct which in any way creates a disturbance.
- **5.** Two (2) or more persons gathered together that have a common identifying sign or symbol or an identifiable leadership that suggest affiliation with a "gang". This includes flashing of hand signs, displaying logos, or the wearing of any clothing or attire such as sagaing pants, shirts, iewelry, bandanas, beanies or hats that suggest gang affiliation.
- **6.** Creating litter by discarding any paper, glass or other matter of the kind anywhere except in a designated trash receptacle.
- 7. Defacing, damaging or destroying any real or personal property constituting part of, or located on property.
- **8.** Yelling, screaming, singing playing of musical instruments, radios, CD or MP3 players or otherwise communicating in a manner which creates noise or sufficient volume that interferes with the hearing or peace of customers, retailers, and/or employees of the property. (Includes Flash Mobs & Scavenger Hunts.)
- 9. Sitting anywhere or on anything other than designated chairs, benches or lawn areas.
- 10. Possessing any open container of alcoholic beverages.
- 11. Running, Skating, Skateboarding, bicycling, obstructing to interfering with the free flow of pedestrian traffic, or with customers view of windows, and/or other retailers or center displays.
- 12. Engaging in commercial and non-commercial expressive activity without the prior written permission of the center management such as photo taking, video recording, handing out flyers, flash mobs, scavenger hunt, etc.
- 13. Soliciting money or other contributions or donations, or distributing commercial advertising or promotional material of any kind, or offering samples of items which are sold, available for sale, or exchange for donation or contribution with out the prior written permission of the center management.
- 14. Smoking inside public restrooms, service corridors or prohibited areas.
- 15. No unlawful carrying of firearm; as this is private property.

Guests who do NOT act responsably may be asked to leave. If they fail or refuse to leave the property, they may be banned for a minimum of six (6)months up to and including arrest and prosecution for criminal trespassing. Rev. May 2015
